Range & Safety Procedures

- 1) Keep your Pistols cased at all time. Holstering will not be permitted at this match.
- 2) You will be called to the Firing Station. At that time place your Pistol case on the tray and un-case your Pistols with the muzzles pointing down range.
- 3) Load each Pistol with (5) rounds each and place them on the tray with the muzzle pointing down range. Hammer must be on an empty chamber.
- 4) At the beep pick up your first Pistol and shoot the Stage as prescribed. Re-stage your first pistol on the tray. Pick up your second Pistol and finish shooting the Stage. Re-stage your second Pistol on the tray.
- 5) Wait for your target to be retrieved and scored.
- 6) Re-load your Pistols for the next stage and wait for the Timer Operator's instructions.
- 7) After the final stage is shot and the target is scored, unload Pistols and show clear to the Timer Operator.
- 8) You may now case your Pistols and leave the Firing Station.

Keep your Pistols cased at all time except when on the firing line

Keep your muzzle pointing down-range at all times NCOWS approved Pistols and ammunition only
